SEE Hawaii Work is a State of Hawaii subsidized employment program that provides you with on-the-job training and assists employers with their employment needs. Subsidized wages are available to support job training.

Our program setting includes classroom and individual sessions. You will be supported by a Job Coach and on-the-job mentor assigned by employer. Services are individualized based on your input and frequency of services is determined by your needs. Individuals must be referred by Department of Human Services (DHS). Contact your First-to-Work case manager for the next available start date.
